The best place to find information on immunizations is on the Center for Disease Control and Prevention website. This website will give you a precise health outlook on the region you will be travelling to.

Is it safe in the Dominican Republic?

Yes, the DR is friendly to the US and entry is easy. The C&MA has made a conscious effort to not put any mission team in a position that would put them in danger; they have not had any problems with the group feeling unsafe. While in the DR you will have electricity, hot showers, flushing toilets, beds with cushions and purified water.

What is the climate in the DR in July?

The temps range from 90 - 100 degrees Fahrenheit and 90 - 100% humidity
